Notice to the Employees/Workmen of Jet Airways (India) Limited

A corporate insolvency resolution process for Jet Airways (India) Limited ("**Company**") has been initiated via Hon'ble NCLT order ("**Order**") dated 20th June 2019 wherein Mr. Ashish Chhawchharia was appointed as the interim resolution professional ("**IRP**"). In terms of the said Order and regulation 6 of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India (Insolvency Resolution process for Corporate Persons) Regulations, 2016 ("**CIRP Regulations**"), the IRP has also made a public announcement dated 24th June, 2019 inviting creditors to submit their claims outstanding as on the insolvency commencement date (i.e. 20th June, 2019). Claims are requested to be submitted by 4th July 2019.

As per regulation 9 of the CIRP Regulations an employee/workman of the company may file their claims with the IRP in the format provided in Form D in the CIRP Regulations. Where there are dues to numerous workmen or employees, an authorised representative may submit one claim (with proof) for all such dues on their behalf in the format provided in Form E in the CIRP Regulations.

While submitting the claim form (whether as authorized representative or individually as an employee/workman), you are requested to study the instructions on the form carefully and attach all the relevant supporting documents. It is very important that your claim should only include amounts due to you up to and as on the insolvency commencement date i.e. 20th June, 2019.

In case you wish to individually file your claim you may choose to file the same in form D by accessing the link - <https://jetairways.wcgt.in/>. Forms may be submitted in person, by post or by electronic means.

The list of Creditors will be uploaded on the website of the company (www.jetairways.com) and or on <https://jetairways.wcgt.in> in due course. The employees can check the status of their claims lodged and admitted in the list of creditors. In case there are any queries or any rectification is to be done, the same can be communicated along with supporting documents to substantiate their claim at – employees.jetairways@in.gt.com.
